DAY 0 Sunday 23rd Sept

After taking a few snaps and a comfort break we then head off to Applecross for lunch via the famous Bealach na Ba Road. Famous for its fish dishes, the Applecross Inn offers a welcome rest before we undertake some fabulous roads around the coast passing the Scottish home of McLaren F1 designer Gordon Murray and heading up an awesome route to our rest stop for the night at the town of Ullapool.

Continuing along some epic roads which hug the coastline we pass through Lockinver, cross the Kylesku Bridge and visit the Smoo Caves.
